On Wednesday the big event is the Buttercup concert at the Tamworth Town Hall.

Thursday's highlight will be joining [Stephen Rowe](#) as his guest to sing the female part on his current duet, *Let's Fall in Love Again*. This popular track has made as a duet finalist in the Victorian Music Awards. Stephen originally recorded it with Tania Kernaghan and when she couldn't make it to Tamworth; he invited me to join him to sing her part.

Friday is another busy day, starting with an up close and personal luncheon performance on the train. Then down to the Musician's Head Quarters where I am presenting a workshop on protective Vocal Technique as part of the educational seminars presented in the [Music Know How - Know How it Works](#) Day.
