I wanted to adapt

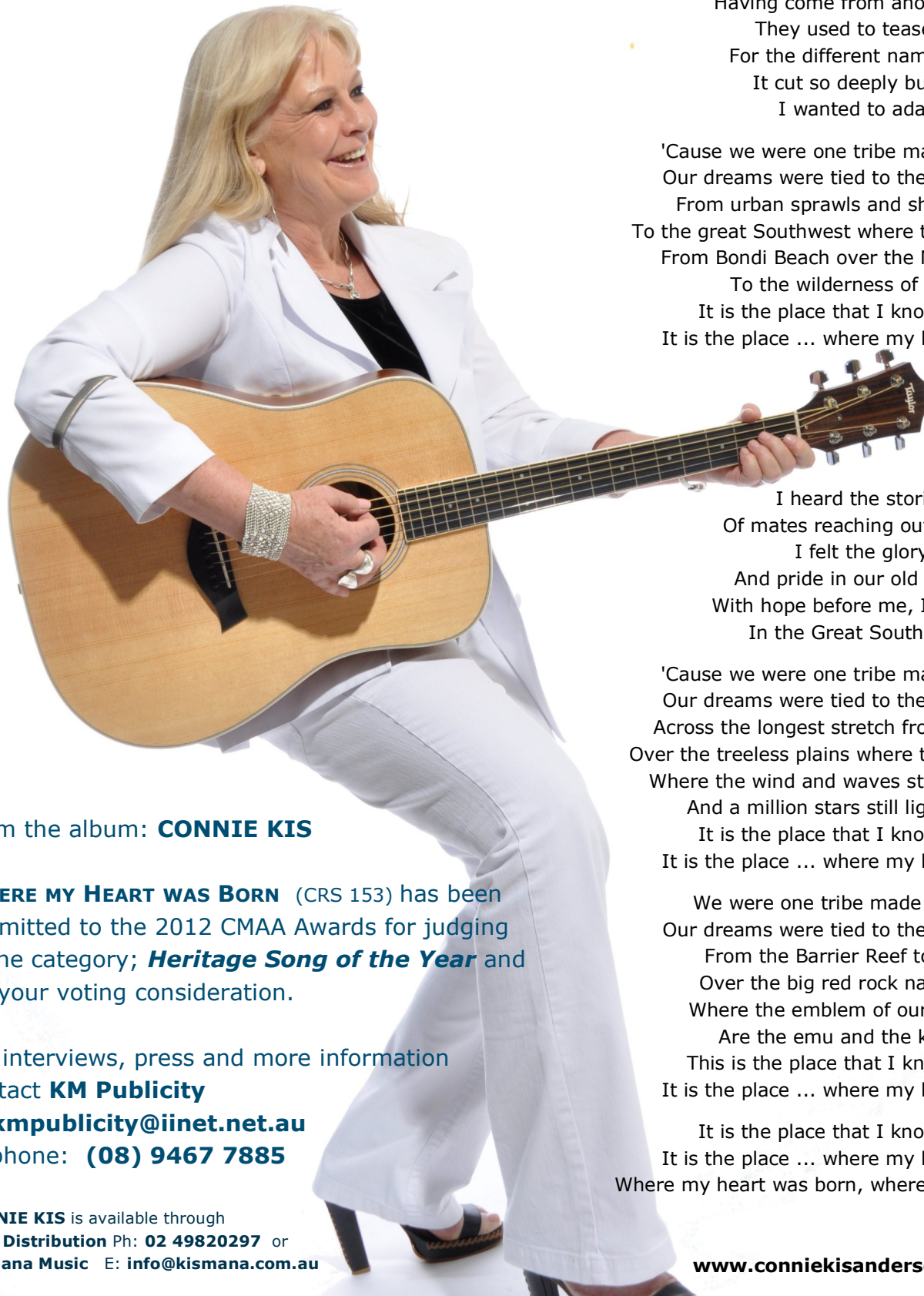
'Cause we were one tribe made from many
